

Gwinnett Gladiators Lou Dickenson 2007-08 game used gloves.

Orleans, Ontario native Lou Dickenson was drafted in the fourth round, 113th overall, by the Edmonton Oilers in the 2000 NHL Entry Draft. In 56 games with the Gladiators during the '07-08 season, Dickenson posted 28 goals with 34 assists for 62 points and second place in team scoring behind Jeff Campbell. He also played nine games in the American Hockey League that season for Manitoba and Hershey. Dickenson then went to Europe where he played for numerous teams over eight years. Following the 2015-16 season, he announced his retirement from hockey. These Reebok HG5K 15" gloves show moderate wear with some loose threads and palms that are in good condition. Dickenson's number 54 is written in black sharpie on the palm. The gloves were purchased from another collector who obtained them from a team equipment sale.
