

Macon Trax Libor Svindl 2002-03 inaugural season game worn jersey, size 56.

Libor Svindl's professional hockey career spanned seven leagues over nine seasons. The Czech Republic native played for two seasons with the Mohawk Valley Prowlers from 1998-2000, after attending the Columbus Cottonmouths training camp in the fall of 1998. After two seasons with limited play back in the Czech Republic, Svindl played 24 games with the Macon Trax during the team's inaugural season in 2002-03, finishing -11 in plus/minus with six assists. It was Svindl's last season in North America. This white OT Sports jersey has a large four color sewn on embroidered primary logo on the front, with two sewn on embroidered alternate logos on the shoulders. The sleeve and back numbers consist of sewn two color twill applied in three layers. These unusual bold font numbers were only found on these first season jerseys. A matching fabric nameplate has sewn on single color twill letters. On the right rear hemline, there are two sewn on embroidered patches, the ACHL league patch and the OT Sports patch. On the lower left side but higher up is a sewn on embroidered Cox Communications sponsor patch. There is good game wear on the sleeves. I purchased this from an eBay auction.
