

University of Georgia Alex Carey 2014-16 game used jersey, size XXL.

Lawrenceville, Georgia native Alex Carey played for the Amarillo Bulls in the NAHL Junior A hockey league prior to coming to the University of Georgia, where he named was named team captain. During his first year with the Ice Dawgs, Carey was selected to the ACHA Division III National Team. According to the team, these white AK jerseys were reportedly worn for at least five seasons from 2011-16. This jersey was probably only worn by Carey for the 2014-15 and 2015-16 seasons because there were no other players on previous rosters wearing #20. The three color twill G logo on the front is heat pressed to the jersey. The numbers and the captain's C are two color heat applied sim-stitch twill. An embroidered AK logo is heat pressed on the right rear hemline. The jersey has great wear, with the front logo, the captain's C and some of the numbers beginning to peel off. It has been photo matched to pictures taken of Carey following the Ice Dawgs victory over the University of Florida for the 2015-2016 SECHC Championship. The team retired #20 on November 30, 2018 as a tribute to Carey. I purchased this directly from the team.
