

University of Georgia Zach Flasch 2016-18 game used jersey, size XXL.

Chicago, Illinois native Zach Flasch played four seasons with the Ice Dawgs and was selected to the 2015-16 3rd Team ALL SECHC team. Before attending the University of Georgia, Flasch played youth hockey in the Chicago area and was a member of the 2009 Treiber's Leafs hockey club that won the International Silver Stick tournament. Silver Stick is the oldest hockey tournament in North America and hosts the winners of regional contests across the United States and Canada. He was named to the 2016-17 SECHC All Academic Team, meaning he had a cumulative GPA of 3.20 or higher. This white Reebok jersey was worn for two seasons by Flasch. The classic bulldog head on the front is embroidered to the jersey and the two color GEORGIA name is sewn on twill. On each shoulder are G logos embroidered directly to the jersey. Sewn on the back and sleeves are numbers consisting of two color sewn twill. The Reebok wordmark logos on front and back are embroidered directly to the jersey. There are numerous stick marks and wear all over this classic jersey made up for the team's 30th anniversary in 2016-17. I purchased this directly from the team.
