People love to judge other people and give advice, even when they don't have much to offer. As Jesus points out in today's Gospel, we can be particularly prone to offering unnecessary, as well as ill-conceived, advice in the spiritual or moral realm. It can seem so clear to us what needs to happen in someone's life that it's hard to hold back. But here too is where a major challenge lies: God sees everyone's big picture.

He has every person in the palm of his hand— even the people you understand the least. This means that you can leave everyone else to his care. You don't have to worry about changing them! Of course, you should love the people around you and be involved in their lives. But try to do it by treating them with the same merciful, loving approach that God has. Seek to understand and empathize, not condemn and overadvise. Think of 1 person whom you are most tempted to judge or give advice to. Finally, watch for the next conversation, and lead with love rather than correction.
