One thing we can't imagine is that she went back to living the way she had in the past. This is what happens when we have an encounter with God's mercy. Do you want to have this kind of encounter? The words Jesus spoke to this woman are essentially the same words the priest says to us in Confession: "I absolve you from your sins." Let Jesus' mercy set you free. Then spend the remaining days leading to Easter thanking him for loving you so much. Let your gratitude move you to follow your Savior even more closely-and to be just as merciful to the people around you as he is to you.
