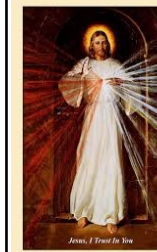

It happened just about every time God revealed himself. Ezekiel saw God coming in the clouds, surrounded by rings of fire, and he fell on his face in awe. Jesus told John, "Do not be afraid," and then proceeded to give him messages for the churches. Isaiah had his sins purged, and God called him to be a prophet. And Jesus told Peter, "Do not be afraid," and then called him to become a disciple. Do you see the pattern? In each story, God made it clear that the person's past sins and mere mortality didn't post obstacles to him. He was more focused on the work he had for them to do. This is what diving mercy looked like in biblical times, and it's what it looks like today. It's God forgiving our every sin, cleansing our consciences, and easing our fears. It's also God looking sending us out as his ambassadors. Do not be afraid. Jesus says these words to you today. Don't be afraid of God. He loves you and he forgives you. And don't be afraid to share that mercy with the people around you. Forgive them just as you have been forgiven. Let them see in you the merciful face of God.
