**If you have extra produce from your garden** you are welcome to place in the entrance of church to share.

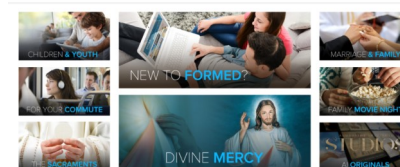
