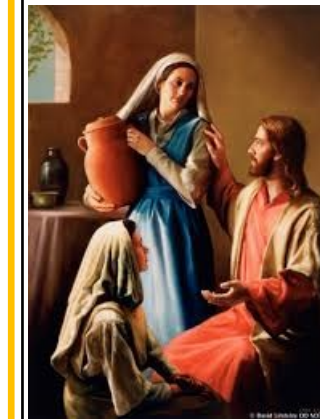

Have you ever been so absorbed in a task that you don't hear someone calling you the first time? That's the situation Martha found herself in when Jesus came to visit. She wanted everything to be just right for her guest, so she set to work. The food had to be perfect, the house spotless, and the kitchen immaculate. Even if she had to do it all by herself— even if all the work drove her half crazy— she was going to do it. "Lord, do you not care?" Martha's question wasn't for a plea for help as much as an accusation. Don't you see how hard I'm working? You should be feeling sorry for me. This is so unfair. Tell Mary to get off the floor and give me a hand. But the only thing that was needed, the only thing Jesus wanted, was to be with her. He wasn't looking for an elaborate meal or a red carpet welcome. He came to share his heart with Mary and her and to invite them to do the same with him. The food would take care of itself. And so, to cut through her stressed-out aggravation, he spoke her name gently. Twice. You don't have to be perfect. You don't have to worry about how every "room" in your heart looks. Jesus is not going to reject you or complain if a few things are out of order. Remember, he entered a world of suffering, spite, hatred, and hurt, and he redeemed it. Right here, right now, Jesus is calling your name. Gently. Twice. Open the door, welcome him in, and come sit at his feet.

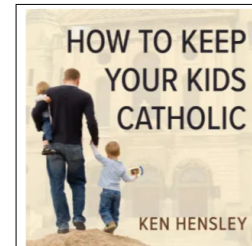
