



But that would be misunderstanding mercy. The father is this parable gives us a glimpse of our heavenly Father. He send Jesus to pour out his entire self to welcome us back home. Jesus revealed God's shockingly generous mercy. This is the mercy that God has for you—and for everyone around you.
