Today readings feature two foreigners suffering from leprosy. Both were miraculously healed by the God of Israel. These readings underscore the truth that God is the God of all the nations. When Jesus was preaching in his hometown of Nazareth, he pointed out that God had chosen not the "insiders," but Naaman and the widow in Zarephath to whom he sent his prophets. In a similar way, Jesus praised the faith of the Samaritan who returned to thank him. It seems that God sometimes uses outsiders to

shake up the people on the inside who may have grown complacent about their faith. God can still use people on the periphery to open our eyes and give us a different perspective. For example, a person who comes to Mass for the first time may have lots of questions. As someone who has been attending Mass for years, you might have taken such rituals and prayers for granted. But now you dig a little deeper to learn more about the liturgy. Or suppose you become friendly with a Christian from another tradition who isn't shy about praying with people. He might show you how to be bolder in prayer. We can all benefit from a different perspective. So get to now people outside your normal circles. God just might have something important to show you through them. "Jesus, thank you for all the people who help me to grow in my faith.'


