Today marks the end of the Christmas season. The stories of Jesus' birth are over. Baptized by John and filled with the Holy Spirit, Jesus is now ready to proclaim the good news. Today's feast offers an answer. Jesus isn't waiting for the world to come to him; he is going out to it. He will accept baptism and then go out and "bring forth justice to the nations." Filled with the Holy Spirit, he will travel all over Palestine and "open the eyes of the blind . . . bring out prisoners from confinement, and from the dungeon, those who live in darkness." Ever since the day of his baptism, Jesus has been going out into the world. First he did it himself. Then he sent out Peter and Paul and the other apostles. And now he is sending you. But don't worry; he's not sending you out alone. You are part of the "world" that Jesus is going out to minister to. Today and every day, he comes to fill you with the same Spirit that filled him at his baptism. So place yourself in today's readings. You are God's child, and he is pleased with you. He is asking you to "bring forth justice" to the little corner of "the nations" where you live—and he is with you to help you do it. "Here I am, Lord! Send me out to share your good news."

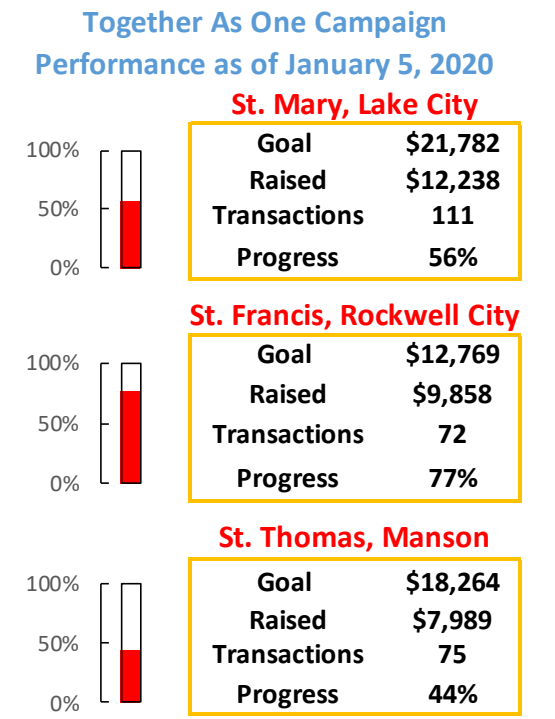
