**Term Limits.** The "Vote Lake Bluff" caucus favors term limits (2 terms), however, the Town Meeting voters' preferences will be respected.

**Method of Voting.** a) For determining the candidate or candidates selected for nomination, voting shall be by written ballot. Fifty-one percent (51%) or more of the votes of all ballots cast shall be necessary to select a nominee. Additional rounds of voting will be among the remaining candidates. b) However if the number of candidates for a particular office does not exceed the number of candidates to be selected, then voting may be by voice vote.
