# "Lord, Pour Me Some Tea" [AUTHORITY]

Luke 10:19, 20 (KJV)

<u>"Behold, I give unto you power [exousia \*ex-oo-see-ah\* =</u> <u>authority] to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the</u> <u>power [dumamis = force; strength] of the enemy: and nothing</u> <u>shall by any means hurt you. Notwithstanding in this rejoice</u> <u>not, that the spirits are subject unto you; but rather rejoice,</u> <u>because your names are written in heaven."</u>

### WHAT DOES AUTHORITY MEAN?

• AUTHORITY [*radah = rule; dominion; power*] is best defined as the power and/or right to decide, control, command, or determine.

Before we dive deep into this word, we must first understand what **AUTHORITY**, our authority, God has given us ... **Genesis 1:26-28** 

Being in AUTHORITY is not about your POSITION, but it's about your PURPOSE ... In other words, it's not about the <u>PLACE YOU'RE IN</u> but it becomes about the <u>PRIORITY OF</u> <u>WHAT YOU'RE THERE FOR</u> ... Some *PEOPLE* have *POSITION*, but have no *PURPOSE* ... Luke 9:1, 2; 37-43 (ref: <u>Matthew 17:14-21</u>)

\*<mark>Footnote</mark>\*

#### There are some things you can't just <u>DECLARE</u> because and out of your POSITION, you have to <u>DEMAND</u> because and out of your PURPOSE. In other words, you can't just <u>CALL</u> a demon out, you have to <u>COMMAND</u> him to come

<mark>out.</mark>

(*Come out, come out, wherever you are*)

Please understand that **AUTHORITY** has nothing to do with the <u>WEIGHT</u> (*power*) of your rule, but it is the <u>WORTH</u> (*purpose*) of your rule. In other words, it's not about the power you have to rule, but it's about the purpose of why you rule ... **Proverbs 29:2 / Ezekiel 34:2-4** 

Those who are in <u>AUTHORITY</u> (governmental, parental, spiritual, etc), must know how to rule well in order for there to be honor ... <u>1 Timothy 5:17; 2:1-3</u>

- Supplications = to make a humble request
- Prayers = devoted petitions to God
- Intercessions = to plead on the behalf of someone else
- Giving Thanks = to express gratitude or praise
  - o (Quiet \*eremos\* = positioned)
  - o (Peaceable \*hesuchious\* = undisturbed or unmoveable)

What is the purpose for <u>AUTHORITY</u>?

 Authority is not just for <u>LINING UP</u> but it is also for <u>LIVING</u> ... <u>Hebrews 13:7; 17</u> God has given us <u>AUTHORITY</u> over everything. However, there are (3) main areas He has authorized us to operate in <u>AUTHORITY</u> in our lives ... AUTHORITY OVER
