

“You Are My Savior”

Psalms 106:8-10 (KJV)

“Nevertheless he saved (Heb. *Yasha* - to rescue; to free) them for his name's sake, that he might make his mighty power to be known. He rebuked the Red sea also (he opens up what was hindering the progress), and it was dried up: so he led them through the depths, as through the wilderness. And he saved them from the hand of him that hated them, and redeemed (Heb. *ga'al* – purchase) them from the hand of the enemy.”

SAVIOR – the title of the One who saves, rescues, and/or delivers from danger.

JESUS, (whose name mean **Jehovah Saves Us**), is considered as our Savior, simply because He is the redeemer of our souls and lives.

Jesus Christ is the **ONLY** true Savior of the world.

With His life, Christ paid the ransom for our lives and gave us.

One cannot truly classify Christ as their Savior, unless they have accepted Him as their personal Lord and know that it was Him that showed up and saved them in the midst of struggle.

If Christ has saved you, then you must do all you can to stay saved. Salvation is not something you pick up and put down when it's convenient. It is NOT a LIPSTICK, but it is a LIFESTYLE.

So how are we saved?

- Through the **INVITATION** of God
 - **Luke 19:10**
 - **1 Peter 2:9**
 - **Titus 3:5, 6**
- Through the **PROFESSION** (*openly announce*) and my belief in God's Word
 - **Titus 1:3**
 - **2 Timothy 1:8-10**
 - **Ephesians 1:13; 2:8**
- Through **CONFESSION** (*to acknowledge*) of the mouth
 - **Romans 10:9, 10**

So what happens after you are saved?

- There ought to be **CELEBRATION**
 - **Psalms 107:1, 2**
- There ought to be **REVELATION**
 - **Psalms 20:5-7**
