## "You Are My Healer"

Psalms 6:2 (KJV)

"Have mercy upon me, O LORD; for I am weak: O LORD, heal me; for my bones are vexed."

Scripture Breakdown: "Have mercy (heb. Chanan – to have pity; to bestow kindness) upon me, O LORD; for I am weak (heb. Umlal – sick; feeble): O LORD (heb. Y@hovah – Jehovah), heal (heb. Rapha – to cure; to mend; to repair) me; for my bones (heb. Etsem – the frame of the body) are vexed (heb. Bahal – trembling inwardly; suddenly agitated)."

Is there a difference in doctor and healer? Yes there is.

- <u>DOCTOR</u> is a person who is licensed to practice medicine
  He's only the SUPPLIER of a CURE
- <u>HEALER</u> a person who specializes in restoring health and wholeness
  - o He's the SOURCE of the CURE

The psalmist, Lizz Wright said, "God specializes in things thought impossible / And He will do what no other / No other power but Holy Ghost power can do / God specializes / When your body / Is full of disease / And your medicines / It don't give you no ease / God specializes." This song simply suggests to us that the Lord is a MASTER SPECIALIST in providing HEALING for Hs people.

When we think of the Lord as our <u>HEALER</u>, we normally associate it with Him being a doctor. However, unlike doctors who have to be present with you, when the Lord <u>HEALS</u> you, <u>HE CAN HEAL YOU</u> WITH A WORD!

- Psalms 107:19, 20
- Matthew 8:6-8, 13

The Lord's assignment of healing was given at the beginning of His ministry. However, He was not licensed to practice medicine; He was anointed to be the medicine.

- <u>Luke 4:18, 19</u> (physical healing)
- <u>Luke 5:31, 32</u> (spiritual healing)
- Psalms 41:4 (eternal healing).

In other words, the Lord is not only the HEALER of the <u>SICKNESS</u> of the <u>SOUL</u>, but over the <u>SINS</u> of the <u>SOUL</u>.

In the healing process, we as human have to trust that God will HEAL us from whatever circumstance, trial, or trouble we face.

The Lord's **HEALING** hand is moved by the prayers of His people. In other words, He positions Himself in our prayers which stirs up a praise.
