I BELIEVE IN THE HOLY GHOST;

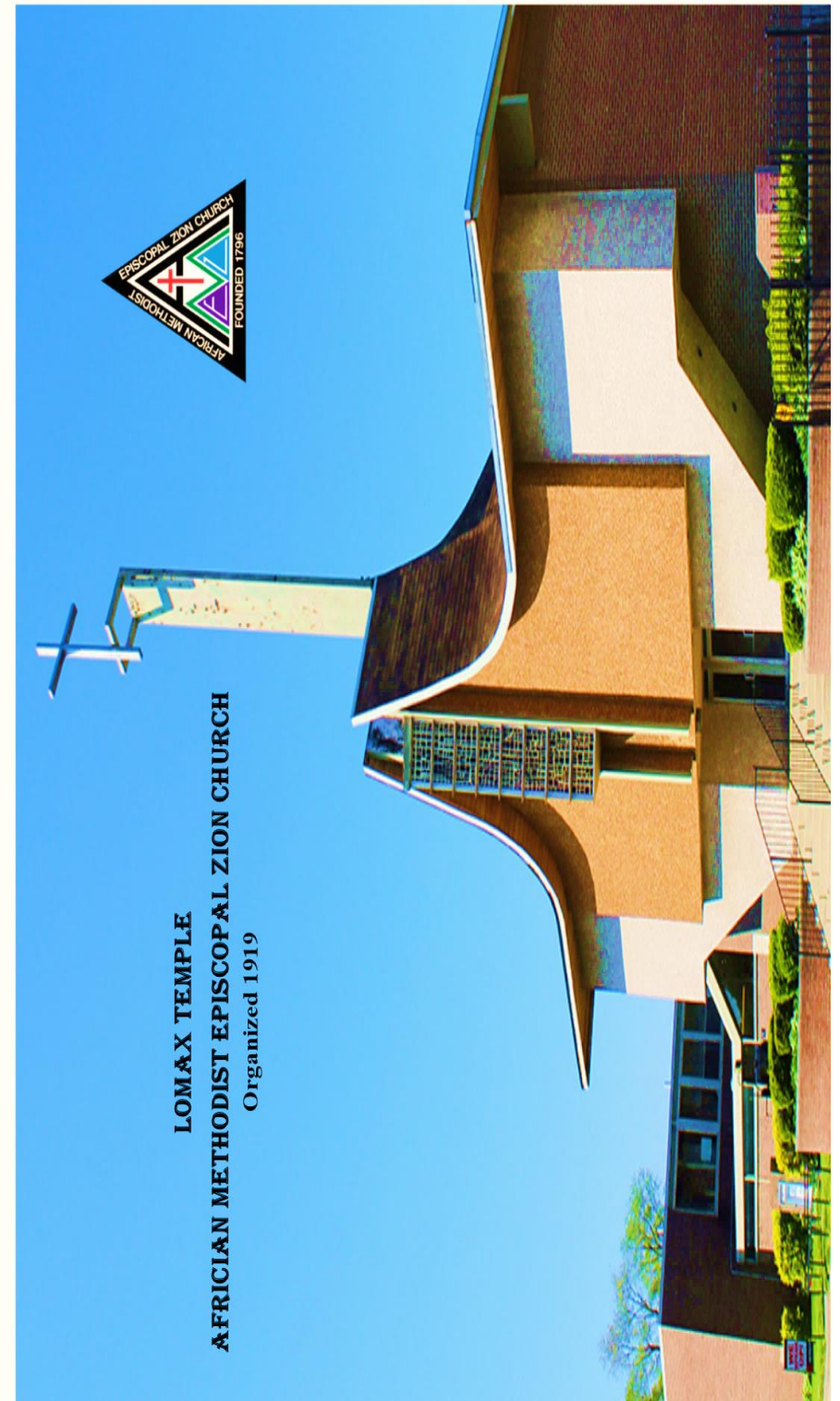
