About: The Scientific & Cultural Collaborative (SCC) works with public school teachers in creating curriculum applications and learning opportunities for students with programs,workshops, assemblies, field trips and professional development for teachers from 27 science, arts, and cultural organizations from the Denver-metro area.

During the school year, an interdisciplinary team of teachers request programs that would aid in reaching standards and curriculum for a segment of the school. The grant provides funding toward buses, substitute teachers, in-services, library support, admission costs, workshop leaders and other supplies to schools at the specific requests of teachers.

Eligibility: K-12 Public Schools in Adams, Boulder, Denver and Jefferson Counties

- Arapahoe, Broomfield, Douglas counties will be eligible in 2020-2021.
- Schools that have received the Alliance Project Grant between 2017-2019 are not eligible.

Application deadline: April 17, 2019

Grant Winners Announced: Early May

Grant Awarded: August 2019-May 2020 School Year

Grant Amount: Approximate value for services varies but can be up to \$11,000 per yearpaid to organizations for programming and schools toward buses and subs. This is not a cash award. Funders: Funding is provided by the members of the Scientific and Cultural Collaborative (SCC) listed below who receive funding from the citizen supported Scientific and Cultural Facilities District (SCFD). Length of Award: 2 years. (1 year guaranteed with evaluation/review to renew for 2nd year. There will also be an opportunity to receive a small 3rd year award to continue programming.)

Requirements: Teachers selected to be on the team must attend 4 (1-hour) meetings throughout the year.

Upon receipt of application, you will be asked to have your principal and lead teacher sign-off an approval/acknowledgement form. If you do not receive this within 48 hours of your application, please contact us.

How does the Alliance Project work?

1. Schools determine a team of teachers/staff from across the curriculum (some areas are required) and also identify a portion of the school (grade level, or GT, AVID, etc. with a maximum of 180 maximum) who will be the focus of the grant.

2. Once selected in May, the Alliance Project Director will come to your campus four times over the year beginning in August for brief planning meetings to hear requests, make suggestions about possible programs, assemblies, field trips, campus workshops, virtual learning, in-school exhibits or professional development training. *Teachers can earn re-licensure consideration for meeting before or after school.

3. Organization contact information will be provided to the teacher who is responsible for discussing details with the organization including selecting dates, times, and content.

4. After the event, the Alliance Project Director will pay the cultural organization directly for the cost of the program and pay support to the school for bus and subs when invoices are received. Seldom are additional funds from the school required.

5. Students and teachers are expected to complete a brief evaluation on each event using an online evaluation system.

* ONLY those organizations listed on the previous page are eligible to participate and provide programs.
