#### **COMMITTEE REPORTS:**

**Building/grounds:** The street light pole on Lincoln was relocated at no cost to anyone. Trustee Esposito is working with Randy and the Mayor on getting trees trimmed around town.

**Health & Safety:** The sidewalk on Market Street is being put in. The crosswalks are finished. Trustee Fitch has been told that lots of people are happy with them and that the flashing beacons grab attention.

Sewer: None

**Water:** The roof has been replaced on the generator building. The leak is back in the water tower from time to time. It will be fixed when the paint inside the water tower is checked in 2018 because the water level will have to be taken down and equipment will be brought in to take care of the water pressure.

**Streets/alleys/sidewalks:** Trustee Fitch received an email about rocking alleys. He will have Randy look into it.

The sidewalk plaque for RTSI is in.

**Budget:** None

**Business:** Update on Pink House. It is not going to auction. Someone is supposed to be opening it back up.

**Zoning:** Dan Ohlson is going to Champaign Park District and will no longer be with Rails for Trails. Hartke got a permit for the concrete pad behind his building.

**Events:** Movie in the Park went very well. Friends of the Library made \$77. The Harvest Festival will be on October 21<sup>st</sup> from 6 to 8 pm at the Grade School.

Trustee Cooper said 9 people showed up for the Events committee meeting. The festival will be August 18, 2018. Movie in the Park will be August 26, 2018.

**Drainage:** No update for Broadway project yet.

Mayor Clements and Trustee Newsom contacted S&S about ideas for fixing flooding problem on Ellen St.

Wauthier present to update on NE drainage project. Original plan will not work so they are looking into 3 or 4 other options. There is a lot of historical research being done for this area. He will report back in a couple of weeks.

**MAYOR:** The final permit for the crosswalk has been approved by IDOT.

If Mayor Clements has to go out of town for work he has named Trustee Newsom as Deputy Mayor.

**OTHER BUSINESS:** Due to budget and staffing Census will have trouble getting their work done.

Trustee Haan has the website ready. He wants everyone to take a look at it.

CatSnap has caught 2 cats recently.

Trustee Cooper cancelled going to the IML meeting do to personal reasons.

Mayor Clements cancelled going to the IML meeting because he may have to go to Florida or Texas for work.
