An Ordinance

Regulating the Installation of Mobile Homes

Whereas the amount of water available is questionable and the present distribution system is limited, it is in the public interest of the citizens of Tehuacana and for the protection of their welfare to limit the number of Mobile Homes placed in the City Limits and to regulate these so permitted within the City Limits.

Now Therefore Be It Ordained By The City Council of the City of Tehuacana:

Section 1. Except as by written permit, by the City Council, the installation of a Mobile Home for use or occupancy as a residential dwelling within its corporate limits shall be prohibited.

Section 2. A replacement home must meet HUD Code requirements and have a permit before installation.

Section 3. Installation of Mobile Homes shall be limited to one unit per property owner.

Section 4. Upon application, the installation of a HUD Code manufactured home may be permitted in those areas determined appropriate by the City Council.

Section 5. Installation of a mobile home without obtaining a proper permit shall be deemed a violation of this ordinance and cause to withhold water service.

Section 6. It is the intent and purpose of this ordinance to have all Mobile Homes within the city limits in compliance with Art. 5221f and as amended S.B. 1267.

Section 7. To become effective September 1, 1985. Passed and approved this 21st day of August 1985.
