## Talent Show Rules

- 1. Division 1: Age 5-9 (division does not advance on).
  - Division 2: Ages 10-15 years of age (rules below apply).
  - Division 3: Ages 16-21 years of age (rules below apply).
- 2. Contestant must compete in and win the Youth Talent Contest sanctioned by their County Fair. Contestants must legally reside in the county they represent for six months immediately preceding the county contest or must be a full-time student who has attended school (academic, not dance, etc.) in that county for one full semester immediately preceding that county's contest. In the event a contestant's parents are divorced and live in separate counties, and have been court ordered to reside jointly with both parents, a contestant may only compete in one of the two counties in which the contestant's parents reside.
- 3. After winning at the county level, no substitutions of individuals in any act will be allowed at the State Contest. Also, contestants may not change categories after winning at the county level, but may change selection of song, music, outfit.
- 4. If a county winner is unable to compete at the State Contest, the County Contest Director can appoint a runner-up to replace them.
- 5 A contestant will ONLY be allowed to compete in two (2) categories.
- 6. Talent presentation must not exceed three (3) minutes at state competition.
- 7. A contestant may not enter both the Talent Contest and the Queen or Teen Pageant.
- 8. Contestants must be single, never married, and no children.
- 9. Youth talent contestants must submit entry form by deadline date. No exceptions.
- 10. Failure to abide by any of the above rules will result in disqualification.
- 11. The dress code is completely optional but must be in good taste.
- 12. A local winner who has won grand champion at State Fair on final night is not eligible to compete at county fair talent show in that category until they have set out one (1) year.
- 13. Cash prizes will be awarded to winners in all three categories.
- 14. All contestants must be checked in by 6:00 at the sound tent.
- 15. All contestants must provide their own instruments, cords, amps, or soundtrack.
- 16. Background vocals are not suggested; excessive use of background vocals will result in point deduction. Time overage will also result in point deduction.
- 17. If you are a vocalist and accompany yourself on the piano or guitar, this is considered Variety Division.
- 18. Previous year talent show winners at county level are eligible to compete.
- 19. MUSIC MUST BE ON CD! We do not accept music on phone or USB.
- 20. All contestants other than winners are eligible for the District fair (AROK State Fair Talent Show Sept 28th, 2019)

All contestants must be checked in by 6:00 at the tent with Bill.

Please have music labeled with name.

You may register for talent show at the Pageant Registration Meeting on Aug.  $31^{st}$  from 10:00 - 11:30am at the stage area.
