(Kaukauna, WI) - If off season pit stall purchases are any indication the Fox River Racing Club's "Thursday Night Thunder" program will have a banner year with half-mile car counts that haven't been seen in many years at Wisconsin International Raceway in Kaukauna.

FRRC president Tom Gee said all 52 poured concrete slab pit stalls located in the D-shaped, half-mile's inner pit area are all sold out. "We're working with Ginger (Van Daalwyk) and Dan (Van Daalwyk) to add eight more poured slabs that will push us to 60 stalls total," said Gee. "We anticipate filling those 52 slabs weekly between the super late model and late model car counts. Fans young and not-so-young will have full access to the pit area and can meet the drivers with their new cars and mingle with the team's crew members as well. "For us it will be a great time for WIR newcomers to explore the facility and learn what to expect on race day and become part of the greatest race fan family in the country," said WIR's Ginger Van Daalwyk. "We encourage all the fans to take selfies with their favorite driver and race car. We're looking forward to a really fun evening!" Both the half-mile and quarter-mile ovals will be available for fans to walk and kids may ride their bicycles on the track and bicycle helmets are required. A stock car and drag car show and shine contest will also take place. Live Music by the band "Around Town" will run from 6:00 pm - 9:00 pm. The concessions & Beer stand in the Oval Pits will be open.

The season opening "Thursday Night Thunder" race at WIR will take place Thursday, May 24 at 6:45 p.m.

Tuesday night oval practices are slated to begin on May 1 with Saturday, May 5 serving as the annual FRRC practice and inspection day from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Spectator admission is free that day.
