- Team Racing – Reminder that this needs to be Pre-announced before season (PRIOR to Sat Practice) go directly to Clint with this info. No exceptions after 5/23/2018.
- Youngest age allowed in the pits is 14 years old with a minor release form
- Pit speed will be monitored. Please be slow in the pits.
- 4 Cylinders will be lined up in the outer pits this year.
- Pit carts and bikes are allowed, but need to be close to the inner wall. We cannot block the track from the safety crew.
- Dells race rumblings: \$3,000 radiators...they will not be allowed. You will still need airflow and a cut out in the nose cone. We will add an amendment to outlaw this, so do not buy one. Brad Strelka mentioned that there is no taping allowed in the UMA series.

- No personal cars in the pits: Only exceptions will be handicapped folks' cars, but we will find a special spot so you are not blocking haulers. Sport trucks and such will need to be parked on the half mile, NOT the big pits.

- Andy Monday asked about practice session details and cost. Fee to get in will be normal pit fees. We will rotate divisions based on which cars are ready for hot laps. Open gate at 9am and practice is 10am to 4pm. Mike Meyerhofer suggested maybe do it like in the past 10am to 1pm ¼ mile and 1pm to 4pm was half mile. We will consider doing it this way. Tom said we will likely do it this way, similar to past years.
