## Fine Art Scans:

This is an important option for Artists who need a bit more attention to their work prior to printing. We have found that the majority of our fine art clients' need scans that require multiple passes for detail ranging from shadows to highlights. It is impossible to get all the information that one needs in one scan so we have devised a process that really works best for our clients who are creating work at the Gallery level and strive for the best quality.

## **Technical information:**

We do not add any sharpening to our scans, we strongly believe that is work that that should be considered in the retouching or print preparation stages. We can scan up to 12,500 dpi. and 48 bit.

## Note:

It is important if you have a print or a jpeg that you are aiming for in terms of color and/or density that we must have that information at the time of ordering your scans. Otherwise we will provide you with flat scans with maximum detail, which for the most part is what our clients require.

This is meant to capture an artwork or photograph that is too large to be scanned on a flatbed surface, from 11x17 to 40x50 inches. Clients are given up to a 200MB file, which can then be used to create prints or other media. If your work is too big, we can come to you! Maybe you have an exhibit/installation that requires documentation for reproduction at a later date.
