Parking at St. Patrick's Church: Please avoid parking at the front of the parochial house – the priest on call uses this route to leave the house. Please do not park on the grass and try to ensure that no entry or exit points are blocked. There have been several instances recently where cars were double parked at the front of the parochial house, meaning there was no way for visitors or clergy to gain access to the house. When parking in Folly Lane, please do not park across the entry to the Parochial House – please do not park across the gates of the nursery school as access is required to the property 24/7.

NEW PREPARATION SESSIONS FOR BAPTISM:

The first session will take place on Thursday 16th May 2019, at 7:30pm in "Patrick's Place" (the crypt at St. Patrick's Church). The first session is for parents of children to be baptized during the month of June and will last a little over one hour. Sponsors are also welcome.

From now on it will be necessary for parents to book Baptisms, giving at least 6 weeks' notice. The dates for future preparation sessions, along with Baptism application forms and other important information can be obtained from the parish office. At the time of booking with Mary, the parish secretary, you will be invited to the 12 noon Mass on the last Sunday of the month before the month of your child's Baptism. At this Mass your child's name will be placed on the overhead projectors and prayer offered for all these children during the prayers of the faithful.

The idea behind this is that your child is introduced to and welcomed by the parish community. Baptisms can now be booked for July, August and Subsequent months, as long as 6 weeks notice is given.

The purpose of the short preparation sessions is to acquaint parents with the meaning and nature of the baptismal ceremony. They will also give the priests an opportunity to meet parents before the ceremony.

The preparation session will be coordinated by lay people from the parish and we are very grateful to them for all the time they have devoted to preparing the programme.

The Diocesan Novena has been a wonderful opportunity for us to come together, in churches and homes across the Diocese, to pray for Vocations to the Priesthood here in Down & Connor. Everyone is very welcome to the Cathedral this Good Shepherd Sunday evening (12th May) at 5pm when the Novena will be brought to a conclusion by Bishop Treanor with the celebration of Evening Prayer.

Following Christ Course: The follow-up course to 'Discovering Christ' continues on Tuesday 14th May. The course is especially for those who attended the first two courses in the Autumn of 2018 and Spring of 2019. The Course – to deepen our faith in Christ – takes place in Patrick's Place (the crypt of the church – every Tuesday (7pm – 9pm)) until June 11th. Light refreshments available.

The Why? Course continues in Patrick's place on Wednesday 22nd May at 8:10pm to 9:30pm.

The topic this month will be 'Why the Church?' Our trainee Deacons Paul and Jackie – with a little help from Fr. Murray – will lead us into a discussion about why we need the church – using modern digital input as well. Even if you missed the previous two sessions you are very welcome to attend.

Vocations Novena: A vocations Novena will begin in the parish on Saturday 11th May and conclude on Sunday 19th May. Booklets for this can be collected in the churches. We encourage <u>families</u> to pray the short prayers and readings for each day together as a family if possible. A copy of each day will be on the Parish Facebook page as well as the parish app.

Holy Hour: A special Holy Hour for vocations will take place on Saturday 18th May at 12pm in St. Patrick's. It will be led by the parish St. Joseph's young priest's society. Each day at Mass there will also be prayers of the faithful offered.

Continuing on May 16th at 10.15am (immediately after Mass) in Patrick's Place – and running over six weeks until June 6th.
