

Troubleshooting Guide:

- Is your robot plugged in?
- Is the volume turned all the way up on your computer?
- Did you hit the record button on the Edison Robot before clicking Program Edison?
- If you have tried #1-5 and your robot won't program correctly, try turning the volume DOWN by about 10%.
- · Ask another student
- · Check and Change 2 of the batteries
- Check and make sure the accessibility feature "mono audio" is turned off.
