Bills Signed Into Law During the 2019 Legislative Session

HB 27	CHAPARRAL LIBRARY FEASIBILITY STUDY	House Bill 27 directs a feasibility study for constructing a library and multi-use facility in Chaparral, which is believed to be the largest community in New Mexico without a public library. Currently, residents have to travel to Anthony or Las Cruces, NM, or El Paso, TX, to access library resources. A library and multi-use facility in Chaparral will serve to connect people and ideas, foster a vibrant and robust community, offer enrichment opportunities for residents' health and well-being, and provide a safe learning environment for students and adults alike.
HB 47	SCHOOL EMPLOYEE & ASSISTANTS PROBATION TIME	House Bill 47 shortens the probationary period for non-licensed school employees, such as custodial and cafeteria workers, and licensed educational assistants from 3 years to 1 year, after which they can only be terminated for just cause. This will help ensure fairness and provide greater job security to some of the lowest-paid school employees.
HB 48	AUDIOLOGIST & HEARING AID SELLER ETHICS RULES	Currently, most purchasers of hearing aids are not making informed decisions because they aren't aware of the availability of devices that provide direct connections between the hearing aid and assistive listening systems, as exist in many public places like concert halls and theaters. House Bill 48 mandates rules requiring that audiologists and hearing aid dispensers inform prospective purchasers of the availability of devices with this technology—greatly improving the quality of life of individuals who have suffered hearing loss.
HB 55	AGREEMENT TO ELECT PRESIDENT BY POPULAR VOTE	House Bill 55 adds New Mexico to the National Popular Vote Interstate Compact, under which states pledge to allocate all of their electoral votes to the winner of the nationwide popular vote in presidential elections. The compact won't go into effect, however, until it includes states representing a majority (270) of the country's electoral votes. The effort is intended to better achieve the constitutional principle of "one person, one vote."
HB 589	COMMUNITY SCHOOL, EARLY CHILDHOOD & PRE-K	House Bill 589 expands the purpose of the Community Schools Act to address the cultural and linguistic needs of students from early childhood programs and voluntary public pre-kindergarten through high school graduation by partnering federal, state, local, and tribal governments with community-based organizations to improve the coordination, delivery, effectiveness, and efficiency of services, align and leverage community resources, and integrate funding streams.
SB 270	"RUDOLFO ANAYA I LOVE TO READ DAY"	SB 270 establishes a day to remember a great New Mexico author. Rudolfo Anaya is a writer and educator who was born in Pastura which lies in Guadalupe County. His works include Bless Me, Ultima, Heart of Aztlán, The Legend of La Llorona, as well as many others. While getting his master's degree in English, he worked as an English teacher in the Albuquerque public school district. Anaya is nationally recognized as writer, being the recipient of the 2001 National Medal of Art, and a recipient of the 2015 National Humanities Medal, both awarded for his work in expanding the multiculturalism of America.

SB 489	ENERGY TRANSITION ACT	Senate Bill 489, the Energy Transition Act, is an historic and transformative measure to reduce electricity costs, diversify the economy, invest in local communities, and protect the environment. Specifically, the Energy Transition Act calls for: 50% renewable energy by 2030, 80% by 2040, and 100% zero-carbon resources by 2045; a large renewable energy build-out to create an estimated 8,000 new jobs by 2050; financing to transition away from coal and to protect consumers; and economic relief for communities impacted by coal plant closures. New Mexico communities impacted by coal plant closures will receive nearly \$70 million in direct community investments. \$20 million of these investments will go into three funds overseen by the Departments of Indian Affairs, Economic Development, and Workforce Solutions to assist the Four Corners' economy to diversify the economy. New Mexico's economy will be bolstered by a large renewable energy build-out, with a local workforce trained to supply the needed labor. This bill does not require any coal plant to close.
