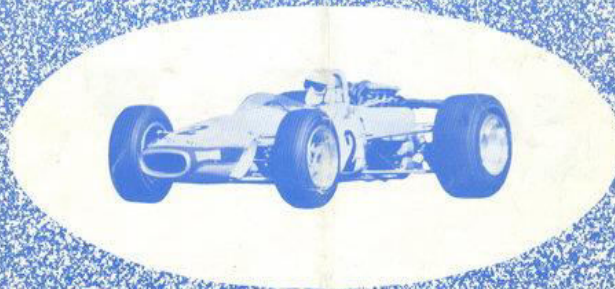

Pen Pictures

ALBERTO PAGANI is 31 and comes from a racing family for his father Kello was a works rider for Gilera and MV, and was eventually the latter's team manager, so much experience has been handed down to Alberto.

Alberto is married to Fank Peris's sister-in-law, and has a four-year-old daughter. He started racing in 1956 on a 125 cc MV and in that year won the junior Italian championship. In 1967, he was second in the 350 cc world championship, and last year won the 500 cc class in the Italian TT.

Today he will be mounted on a two-pot Linto, which, with Frank Findlay, he helped to develop.

PHIL READ is the only overseas rider competing today who has previously ridden at Roy Hesketh circuit, and that was nearly a decade ago. In 1968, he won a double crown when he took both the 125 cc and 250 cc championships, beating Jim Redman in the latter.

At Roy Hesketh he will be seen on a Yamaha TD2 plus a TR3, but it is believed, he will be riding a 500 cc Spanish Ossa in this year's world series. Recent successes include 250 cc and 350 cc wins in the Italian GP on Yamahas, and beating Agostini on the 350 cc MV at Brand's Hatch.
