THREE: Many have asked, "Will we still be meeting for Sunday services?" The answer is YES...we will have "CHURCH ONLINE" on our Facebook Live page. If you are not on Facebook, YOU CAN STILL participate! Simply go to our website www.well.church and click the link, "watch services online". It will ask you if you want to set up a Facebook account, simply respond, "NOT NOW." Then proceed to scrolling to the video of our LIVE service; you can also watch old archived videos there.

Here's the deal, we want you to gather your family, maybe even your small group if you are comfortable, and have a "WATCH PARTY" together. The good thing is we will be streaming ONE SERVICE LIVE at 9:15am this Sunday, March 22nd. BUT, if you prefer the 11:00am time for your family and friends, you can go to the same video page and watch the archived 9:15am service at 11:00am.

Go ahead and turn up the volume, sing along, interact with the comments, and do your part to stay connected. In this season of "social distancing" we REALLY need to stay socially connected, while being physically distanced. Here is a thought: get your family awake and going, gather them, and share a breakfast meal together at 8:30am. By the time you do the kitchen clean up together, the service will be ready to begin online at 9:15am. You could also spend a few minutes after the service talking to one another about what you experienced. We will provide discussion questions for you...and kids curriculum activities for those with kids.

Romans 8:28 says, "And we know that God causes everything to work together for the good of those who love God and are called according to his purpose for them."
