School Safety Tips

- Be on the lookout for school zone signals and ALWAYS obey the speed limits
- When entering a school zone, be sure to slow down and obey all traffic laws
- Always stop for school busses that are loading or unloading children
- Watch out for school crossing guards and obey their signals
- Be aware and watch out for children near schools, bus stops, sidewalks, in the streets, in the school parking lot, etc.
- Never pass other vehicles while driving in a school zone
- Never change lanes while driving in a school zone
- Never make U-Turns while driving in a school zone
- Never text while driving in a school zone
- Avoid using a cell phone
- Unless licensed to do so, never use handicap or emergency
 vehicle lanes or spaces to drop off or pick up children at school
