Coursework includes: Grace Relations, Education Psychology, History of American Education, Education Policy, Educational Leadership, School Law, Strategic Lesson Planning, The Five Environments Pedagogy, Curriculum Development, Learning Theories, Instructional Design and Technology, Educational Leadership, Education Policy, Measurement, Assessment, and Evaluation. Additionally, students are required to complete a teaching internship.

## **Master of Arts of Christian Education**

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The M.A. in Education degree programs prepares students for leadership in education. Coursework includes: School Finance and Management, Human Potential and Growth, Educational Technology and Online Instruction, Educational Research, Guidance and Counseling in Education, Educational Administration and Management, Learning Theories, Instructional Design and Technology, Educational Leadership, and Education Policy, Perceptions of Matterring Seminar. Additionally, students are required to complete a capstone project.

## **Doctor of Education**
