

Description:

The Congenital Heart Collaborative (TCHC), an affiliation between Rainbow Babies and Children's Hospital and Nationwide Children's Hospital heart program seeks candidates for a full-time pediatric sonographer.

Rainbow Babies and Children's Hospital, Cleveland Ohio.

Job Summary:

The candidate will work in an IAC certified institution with a team of 8 sonographers, 12 pediatric cardiologists and pediatric cardiology fellows in-training to provide the highest quality of care for children and adults with congenital heart disease. The successful candidate will spend time at the main campus, in our intensive care units, heart catheterization laboratories as well as one of our outpatient facilities in the Cleveland area. The work schedule includes day shifts, night and weekend calls on a rotating basis.

The candidate will be expected to produce high-quality echocardiograms for interpretation by pediatric echocardiographers, generate reports and perform administrative tasks to contribute to the successful operation of the echocardiography laboratory. Additional responsibilities include teaching, participation in research and quality improvement projects.

This opportunity will allow the successful candidate to expand their scanning skills, broaden their knowledge and experience in echocardiography in children and adults with congenital heart disease through participation in cardiology/cardiothoracic surgery conferences and continued medical education.

Education/Training:

Graduation from an accredited program in cardiovascular ultrasound.

Knowledge of congenital heart disease and a minimum of 2 years of work experience with congenital echocardiography including M-mode, 2-D, 3-D, Doppler and color Doppler.

Required credentials, licensure and/or certifications:

Certification or eligibility for certification by the American Registry of Diagnostic Medical Sonographers, Registered Diagnostic Cardiac Sonographer or Registered Congenital Cardiac Sonographer in pediatrics.

Basic life support certification.

The candidates will be well supported at a world class Children's Hospital with over 60 years of experience in the care of pediatric and adult congenital heart disease; an outstanding educational and research enterprise at Case Western Reserve University School of Medicine and an internationally recognized program partner with the Nationwide Children's Hospital Heart Center.
