This incident happened in July 1959, in Alor Islands area located in the northern side of East Nusa Tenggara province, in Indonesia. Mr. Alwi Alnadad, a retired policeman, told the story. He was the head of police office in Alor Islands area

when it happened. He told there were six aliens who came in to the area. They have long arms, wavy silver-color-hair, and some of them have beard. They wore blue clothes with high collar, belt with some gray cylindrical stick and shoes that looked like black military boot. Some inhabitants stated that they searched for something. A report quoted that a six-yearold kid was kidnapped and then left with disordered mind in some field area.

Finally, some policemen waited for them and soon they met the aliens. At last, the police fired them (from about 13 meters of distance) but they realized none of them were bleeding; not a dead body was found. It was strange cause the police shot them from a very short distance.
