One winter night, my mom and I saw 3 oval-shaped ships moving in a strange way in the sky, for less than a minute. It was 3 years ago but I still remember it clearly. I was with my mom on the balcony of our house, to watch the stars as we usually do on winter time - Orion is my favorite constellation. I'm talking about this experience for the first time officially. I did not know your center existed before today, when I accidentally ended on your page. Well, so I was telling that I went out to watch the stars with my mom, when - after 20 minutes of observing the sky - we both saw at the same time a sort of light, more intense than the stars, but not very neatly. My mom asked me if I could have an idea what it could be, but I couldn't answer, as I realized that the light seemed to get closer and move in a strange way, like no other planes or helicopters do. I know what I'm talking about, since I live next to an airport. My mom's eyes and mine were stuck on the light, which gradually became a sort of oval-shaped ship. Soon, we also realized that it was shortly followed by 2 other smaller objects of the same radiance and abnormal movement. The whole phenomenon lasted for less than one minute, however I will never forget it. I couldn't believe, but my mom was by me and she could confirm that it really happened. We often use to talk about such special night together, but only when we are all alone - even my dad doesn't want to hear about. I hope I have found someone who will not judge me so abruptly.
