The place of the sighting

A group of lights flying in tight linear formation, like an aircraft wing, but occasionally individual lights would break from the pack to fly around and rejoin somewhere else. Moving at some speed and moved with maneuverability which could not have been an aircraft. My girlfriend also witnessed it; she's an ex Singapore Airlines employee and had never seen anything like it before. We had no camera, but the lights were too far up to be clearly seen without strong lenses. I'm a British national, aged 41 and I've lived in Singapore for 3 years. Never seen anything like this before.

Question of UFOinfo “Objects and their shape”:

About 12 shining lights the same altitude of an aircraft or slightly lower, which moved mostly in a linear shape but individual elements; would break from the formation and rejoin it somewhere else; they moved around quickly in such a quick fashion that it could not have been an aircraft or anything man-made.

Clear skies. I was sitting on the beach at Sentosa with my girlfriend on a sunbed looking up at the skies. Our eyes had adjusted to dark and there were stars visible. What we saw was a group of lights moving together at high speed.
