

## *The Road to the 2020 USASF World Cheerleading Championship*



### **2020 Worlds Bid Declaration**

The OCF is permitted to offer 2 At Large Bids to the IASF/USASF World Cheerleading Championships.

#### **Bid Process:**

These at Large bids will be awarded based on the following criteria:

- Judges' recommendation
- For a bid to be awarded, that gym and its athletes **MUST** be a member of their Provincial Sport Organization to be eligible. **\*This should be done ahead of time via providing membership numbers to [membership@ocfcheer.com](mailto:membership@ocfcheer.com)**
- One bid will be reserved for an Ontario based team that is a member of the OCF

The Ontario Cheerleading Federation does not guarantee bids to the highest scoring teams. The OCF may follow the natural progression of scores, but please note that the different scoring systems may require other criteria to be considered when awarding bids.

In the event that a team awarded a bid declines the bid at this competition, the OCF can at its discretion present that opportunity to another worthy participating team.

#### **Weighting of Runs:**

The first run will comprise 50% of the final score. The second run will comprise 50% of the final score.

#### **Scoring Process:**

IASF Divisions will be scored on the IASF score sheet.  
Cheer Canada divisions will be scored on the Cheer Canada Score System.

#### **Eligibility:**

Proof of age (government issued photo ID) will be required for all World's Bid athletes at time of check in. Please be familiar with the IASF and USASF (Cheer Canada) eligibility applicable to your division. Teams with ineligible athletes; any athlete not verified through the Age Eligibility Worlds Check in process may be declared ineligible. (Please remember that this must be completed prior to your first competition run).
