PUTTING YOUR BEST FOOT FORWARD

Students, staff, and school building volunteers must take pride in their personal appearance, dress in a modest manner that will not present health and safety problems, and not cause any type of school disruption.

Pictures or wording on clothing that violates our Christian message are not acceptable

All shirts/dresses for boys/girls must have sleeves

Only during 1st and 4th quarter

Only worn under a dress, skirt, or long shirt/sweater

No higher than 2 inches above the knee



Shoes must be appropriate for weather conditions and various activities

no hats, hoods, or bandanas



no makeup



no holes or rips



no flip flops on physical education days ***



Parents are required to cooperate in enforcing the dress code.
 The school administration reserves the right to make the final judgement concerning appropriateness of student, staff, and volunteer attire.
 ***Flip flops are strongly discouraged. They easily break & can lead to injury.
