Tim Bigelow has returned with airplanes and a travelling work shop that looked like a rocket launcher case, but was only a converted golf club case.


Welcome back Tim.



Stewart Holdsworth from the Stoney Creek Hawks came in to hone up his skills with an indoor flyer.





Our on duty flight instructor, Rick Young, in full instructor mode.




Here we have Glenn Holden getting ready for flight.





I'm not sure but I think Ron Campbell is still talking to that plane.
