Charlottesville Promise Scholarship Preston Coiner Scholarship Grace Tinsley Scholarship

The Charlottesville Scholarship Program (CSP) and Grace Tinsley Memorial Scholarship Program offer eligible local residents an opportunity to apply for Charlottesville Promise, Preston Coiner, and Grace Tinsley Scholarships each year by March 1st.

Charlottesville Promise Scholarships are renewable awards that can fund up to \$9,000 of the cost of an undergraduate education. First-year awards are typically \$1,500.

Preston Coiner Scholarships are renewable for each year of a student's 2- or 4-year undergraduate education. Annual awards are calculated based on a percentage of the funds available in the Preston Coiner scholarship endowment. The Preston Coiner award for 2019 was \$5,000.

Grace Tinsley Scholarships are awarded for a student's first and second years of college. In 2019, first-year awards were \$2,500 and second-year awards were \$1,500.

Eligible applicants may use a single form to apply for one, two, or all three of these local scholarships.

CHS seniors applying for Charlottesville Promise, Preston Coiner, or Grace Tinsley Scholarships should submit their applications to the CHS Counseling Center by March 1st. If students need assistance completing the application and assembling the required supplemental documentation, they should notify Lois Burke (Lois.Burke@charlottesvilleschools.org, 434.245.2410) at the CHS Counseling Center and submit their materials to her no later than February 1st. This extra month is required to give the counseling staff adequate time to help students complete their applications by the March 1st deadline. Please plan accordingly!

Current college student and adult Charlottesville Promise Scholarship applicants, and Preston Coiner Scholarship applicants from high schools other than Charlottesville High School <u>must</u> submit applications directly to CSP either by US mail or email by <u>March 1st</u>. (Postmarked Deadline). **Electronic submission is strongly encouraged.**

It is each applicant's responsibility to submit complete and accurate application packets by the March 1st deadline. **Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.** Please be sure your name appears on all materials submitted on your behalf. Essays submitted for the Preston Coiner Scholarship should be the applicant's own work. All Social Security numbers should be redacted from all supporting documentation.

Charlottesville Promise, Preston Coiner, and Grace Tinsley Scholarships may be used for tuition, fees, and other college expenses.

All scholarship winners must provide the following documentation before scholarship funds will be sent to the college, community college, or technical school the student will be attending:

- Signed Memorandum of Agreement and Acceptance of Scholarship form
- Copy of an official acceptance letter from the accredited two- or four-year college or technical school you will be attending
- College student identification number
- Copy/screenshot of your college tuition invoice
- Verification of Enrollment/Pre-Registration form signed by the college or school registrar
- Completed Student Contact Information form

Charlottesville Promise and Preston Coiner Scholars may apply for renewal of the scholarship for each subsequent year of their two- or four-year degree program or technical school certificate program. (See *Renewal* Instructions on the CSP website.) Charlottesville Promise and Preston Coiner scholarship recipients are expected to maintain satisfactory academic progress, to remain in regular contact with their assigned Navigator, and to report to the CSP Board of Directors as requested.

Grace Tinsley Scholars may apply for renewal of their scholarship for the second year of college. Renewing Grace Tinsley Scholars are expected to maintain satisfactory academic progress and to report to the Grace Tinsley Scholarship Committee as requested.

Income Eligibility Requirements

The Charlottesville Scholarship Program (Charlottesville Promise Scholarships and Preston Coiner Scholarships) and the Grace Tinsley Memorial Scholarship Program (Grace Tinsley Scholarships) provide undergraduate scholarships to low- and moderate-income people in the Charlottesville community who wish to pursue post-secondary education, but who lack the financial resources to do so. To qualify for these need-based scholarships, the applicant's household income must be lower than the maximum moderate income for the applicant's family size, as shown on the guidelines below. Low income figures are provided as a reference only.
