

MY SPIRITUAL JOURNAL

“We admitted that we were powerless over our addiction, that our lives had become unmanageable”

If there is a day I have eaten until I was full; if there is a time of joy I can recall; if I have escaped even once the clutches of death; if I can remember one or all of the above, then I have something to be grateful for.

Life will work for me when I realize ... I must put first things first! The Law of First Things is a mandate for all of our lives. This principle encourages me to acknowledge, accept and embrace the God of my understanding first in all things that I do. First, I inquire of my God. Then, listen to my God. When I hear my God, respond. Then, trust my God to lead and guide me. If and when I do these things, the Law of First Things ensures that the God of my understanding will reward me ten times over. When I breathe, that's my God. When I move, that's my God. When I think about where I need to be and what I need to do, that's my God giving me the power to take the thought and translate it into action. When I speak, that's my God. When I eat, it's my God. For without God's love, God's mercy and grace, nothing I consider important would be possible. The truth of the matter is, God is first. The Law of First Things simply asks that I acknowledge it. When I take my first breath in the morning, I need to remember it's my God who is making it possible. When I swing my feet over the side of the bed, I have to acknowledge my God for moving through me as the source of my life. Before I do one thing in the day for myself or anyone else, I have to thank my God for every ability, talent, gift and opportunity that lies within me or before me. As I move through each day, I keep my God informed about what I am doing and ask that I be guided toward right thought and right action. And I can't forget to invite my God to participate in all of my activities. As my activities begin to bring forth rewards, I thank my God first. If I make an earnest effort to follow the Law of First Things, I will never have to worry about being left out of my God's good will.

Until today, I may have believed that I needed to go someplace special to find the power, strength and love of my Creator.

Just for today, I am devoted to remembering, acknowledging, trusting and expressing gratitude to my God for being present right where I am. Today I am devoted to putting my God first in all things!

Narcotics Anonymous offers us an opportunity to change the way we once lived. As using addicts, we were often characterized by our self-seeking behavior. We thought the world owed us something. We did nothing for anyone without expectation. When we arrived in NA, we were greeted and accepted by people who were just like us. What was different about them is that they learned how to freely give of themselves. They gave love to us until we were able to love ourselves. Our commitment to carry the NA message to other addicts should be motivated out of selfless service. Like our predecessors, we should always strive to serve without looking for accolades. Our clean time and experience does not give us any status over the newcomer. If the newcomer is most important, our service efforts will exemplify that. We will less likely win the newcomer over if our service to them is distasteful. Since we're the first Basic Text the newcomer will see, our behavior should reflect our recovery. Service will never be selfless until we can address the core of our disease with the 12 Steps. In applying spiritual principles, we learn that we can only keep our spirits conditioned by giving freely of ourselves. We keep what we have of our spirituality by giving to the newcomer selflessly.
