Douglas County Cancer Services (DCCS) is experiencing a tremendous increase in requests for support and services from Douglas County residents who are dealing with a cancer diagnosis and treatment.

The Board of Directors has been providing leadership to ensure the funding is available to support the programs that are so very important to cancer patients. In the year ending May 2016, total program dollars spent was \$26,890. As shown above, the program dollars provided is \$32,185 for nine (9) months ending fiscal year 2017. With three (3) months to go in this fiscal year, DCCS will far exceed any of the 28 years in existence.

We are very proud of the progress we have made in assisting more cancer patients in Douglas County. DCCS assists in easing the financial burden of a cancer diagnosis and treatment and hopefully aid these patients in their healing by relieving their financial stress.
