

Fiscal Year June 1, 2017 to May 31, 2018

Financial aid (rent, utilities, misc.)	\$ 23,193
Food Cards for groceries	\$ 10,100
Gas cards for transportation	\$ 7,745
Christmas Food Boxes for cancer patients	\$ 4,061

In 2015 DCCS provided \$18,658 in financial assistance to Douglas County Cancer patients. In 2016, \$26,890 was provided and \$45,194 in 2017. For 2018 \$45,099 was provided to support cancer patients.

For fiscal 2018, a total of 1,077 visitors came to the DCCS office and volunteers received 600 phone calls. Our wonderful volunteers also provided support and services to 164 cancer patients in the form of wigs, prosthesis, bras, hats and/or financial assistance.

Patients come to us with breast, prostate, lung, melanoma, lymphoma, tongue, rectal, liver, ovarian, pancreatic, neuroendocrine, myeloma, colon, leukemia, glioblastoma, cervical, bladder, brain, bone, esophageal, kidney, sarcoma, sinus, testicular, throat, uterine, cervical and oropharynx cancers. We feel very privileged to assist these patients to ease their burden and allow for them to focus on healing.
