12:00pm- Full Ensemble on the band practice field w/ props

1:30pm- Full runs with **PIT CREW**. We will practice set-up and tear down.

3:00pm

- Load Trailers (make sure your stuff is loaded!)
- Please bring Sack Lunch- you will not be allowed to leave for food
- Change into compressions and do show hair (**you are NOT permitted to do this in the band room, use restrooms or atrium**)

Hornline and Percussion- Dress in black compressions, tall **PLAIN** black socks. Do show hair.

Guard- Dress in appropriate undergarments. Do show hair and make-up. Dress in uniform.

5:15pm- Load Buses

5:30pm- Depart for NHS

6:00pm- Arrive at NHS unload trailers (phones stay on the bus, if you are seen with one it will be taken)

- *From the time we arrive at the show to the time we change out of uniforms students are off access to their parents. Your student will be very busy with their pre and post show jobs and it can get VERY crowded at the trailers please do not come back to the trailers unless you are part of the crew. Please do not immediately follow us back to the trailers. Allow your student to do their post show job and put things away. After this you are more than welcome to take pictures and visit with your student.*

9:15pm- Return to trailers and load instruments/props. Drum Majors remain at stadium for awards.

9:30pm- Line up in "The Two Lines", go back as group to stadium in uniform for awards

10:30pm- Return to trailers, change out of uniforms, load bus, and depart for WHS

11:15pm- Unload trucks, meet in band room for dismissal

(Make sure you help with your things, unloading jobs will be given out on show day!)

11:45pm- Watch Video

12:00am- Dismissed (this is an estimate and could vary.)

CLOTHES: WASHERS ARE MANDITORY FOR SATURDAY!!! New 2019 washers and missing washers will be passed out on Saturday. Please make sure that you bring all the items that you need to wear with your uniform. COME PREPARED!!!

EXPECTATIONS: This is our first official contest of the year and we have already come so far from that first rehearsal in June. We are exactly where we want to be at this point in the season. Remember to cheer for ALL bands and at all times represent the WSP with class.

REMINDERS:

- Never go anywhere at a show by yourself. You should never see a WSP member alone at a show.
- DO NOT run around or scream at a show!!!
- Do not play your instrument or spin your equipment at a show before you are told to. This will result in a penalty.
- You are either in your uniform or you are out of your uniform. Do not walk around partially dressed in your uniform.
- We clap for all bands...we do not clap for our selves.
- All absence requests should be turned into Mr. Muth no later than September 2nd
- All Transportation forms should be turned into Mr. Muth no later than September 6th

SHOW MATERIALS REMINDERS:

Hornline and Percussion Students:

- Washers- You will NOT march without them- Will be given out on Saturday
- Tall Plain Black Socks
- Black Compressions (shorts and shirts)- Will be given out on Saturday
- Black Gloves- Will be given out on Saturday
- Large bag for trips
- Materials to do show hair
 - Brush and/or comb
 - Strong Gel
 - Hair Donut (for sock bun)- Long Hair Only
 - Bobby pins and hair ties (that match hair color)- Long Hair Only
