YOU CAN DO THIS BEFORE WARM-UP OR FOLLOWING THE GAME. PLEASE DO NOT IMPEDE THE PROCESS OF GETTING THE BAND BACK TO THE BAND ROOM BY TRYING TO TALK TO YOUR STUDENT WHEN WE ARE TRANSITIONING.

- Change into compressions and do show hair (you are NOT permitted to do this in the band • room, use restrooms or atrium)

Hornline and Percussion- Dress in black compressions, tall PLAIN black socks. Do show hair.

Guard- Dress in appropriate undergarments. Do show hair and make-up. Dress in uniform.

9:10am- Meet in Band Room

9:20am- Load Buses

9:30am- Depart for WHS

11:00am- Arrive at WHS unload trailers (phones stay on the bus, if you are seen with one it will be taken)

From the time we arrive at the show to the time we change out of uniforms students are off access to their parents. Your student will be very busy with their pre and post show jobs and it can get VERY crowded at the trailers please do not come back to the trailers unless you are part of the crew. Please do not immediately follow us back to the trailers. Allow your student to do their post show job and put things away. After this you are more than welcome to take pictures and visit with your student.

Change out of uniforms and into SHOW SHIRTS. You will have time to eat at concession. Please bring \$\$\$. 3:15pm- Meet at the buses line-up in "the two lines" and return to the stadium for awards 3:46pm- Awards 4:30pm- Return to trailers and buses 4:45pm- Load buses and depart for WHS. 6:15pm- Arrive at WHS. Unload trucks, meet in band room for dismissal (Make sure you help with your things) 6:45pm- Watch Video 7:00pm- Dismissed (this is an estimate and could vary.)

CLOTHES: <u>WASHERS ARE MANDITORY FOR SATURDAY!!!</u> Please remember to bring your band shirt for after the performance on Saturday. Please make sure that you bring all the items that you need to wear with your uniform. After our performance on Saturday we will change into band shirts, black shorts or blue jeans, depending on the weather, COME PREPARED. You may also wear any WSP wear if it is cold. (Jackets, Sweatshirts, ect)

**EXPECTATIONS:** Remember to cheer for ALL bands and at all times represent the WSP with class. This week things start to get very competitive. Everyone is working for a spot in the ISSMA Scholastic State Finals. This is a marathon not a sprint! We have what it takes to go the distance all the way to the end. You have the show, the skills, and the drive. Go out there and make it happen. Everyone gives 100% all of the time!

#### **REMINDERS:**

- Never go anywhere at a show by yourself. You should never see a WSP member alone at a show.
- DO NOT run around or scream at a show!!!
- Do not play your instrument or spin your equipment at a show before you are told to. This will result in a penalty.
- You are either in your uniform or you are out of your uniform. Do not walk around partially dressed in your uniform.
- We clap for all bands...we do not clap for our selves.
- All absence requests should be turned into Mr. Muth no later than October 5th
- All Transportation forms should be turned into Mr. Muth no later than October 10<sup>th</sup>
