

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. What do I need to bring to camp?

Linens, pillow, alarm clock, towel, toiletries, shirts, shorts, socks, cleats, sneakers, turfs (optional), hockey stick, mouth guard, shin guards, water bottle, fan.

2. My daughter is a goalkeeper, does she need to bring her own equipment to camp?

Yes, all goalkeepers need to bring all necessary GK equipment in order to practice and compete.

3. What time is check-in on July 31st, 2011?

Check-in on July 31st is from 11-1 PM for all overnight and commuter campers.

4. What time is check-out on August 3rd, 2011?

Check-out on August 3rd is at 12:00 PM

5. What forms do I need to send in?

If you have not already done so, please make sure at the time of check-in you have your completed medical form. The medical form can be found right on this webpage under the link 2011 Camp Medical Form. You cannot participate without this medical form.

6. How do I reach my daughter while she is at camp?

If your daughter does not have a cell phone, you can call the camp director, Felicia at 617-797-7393 anytime.

7. What if my daughter is sick or injured and can not attend camp, will I get a refund?

Refunds can be granted minus \$100 depending the situation prior to July 1st. NO REFUNDS will be issued after July 1st.

8. Are parents allowed to watch?

YES! Parents can watch any of the sessions at camp.

9. Can I send my daughter mail while she is at camp?

In order not to miss your daughter while she is at camp, we recommend sending your mail in advance.

10. What if my daughter happens to get injured or sick while she is at camp?

We have a trainer on campus throughout the entire camp. You will be notified immediately if it is a serious situation.

11. My daughter is driving herself to camp and will have her car, what is the procedure?

Your daughter can drive herself to camp, but she must leave her keys at check in and cannot use her car at all during camp. We will provide a parking pass for her car while camp is in session.
