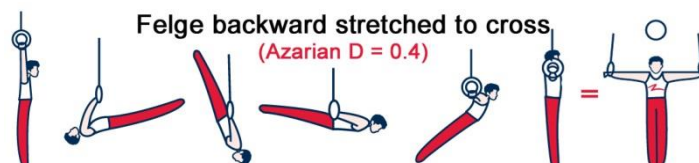

- Entry Fee:** \$115.00 per gymnast (Level 5 – 10 & Elite)  
\$90.00 per gymnast (Level 4)  
\$100.00 per team (make check out to "Azarian Team Cup")

Foreign Entry Fee: \$75.00/gymnast, \$0/team (for gymnasts & teams outside of the US)  
All foreign gymnasts, coaches, & judges must have a USAG membership (\$25.00 ea.)

- Deadline:** **When the meet fills up!** I anticipate that the meet will fill up in late October.
- Entry Fee Deadline:** **November 15<sup>th</sup>**, 2015.
- Refund Policy:** 100% until Jan 1<sup>st</sup>, 50% until Jan 21<sup>st</sup>, No refund after Jan 21<sup>st</sup>.  
No injury refunds after January 21<sup>st</sup>.
- Equipment:** All **new AAI** Equipment (from an official AAI rep, same quality as JO Nationals).

Age Groups – Depending on the entries, some age groups may be combined or split out.

Level 4: **NO scores** are flashed and NO individual or team awards are handed out. We follow the Southern California Level 4 program. March-in is in shorts and t-shirt only, no uniforms. See the Level 4 link on the website for details.

Level 5: In the level 5 divisions, we are separating out those who have competed 1 year or more (in Level 5) from those who are in their first year of Level 5 competition (Level 4 does not count). This will give the first year boys more opportunities for awards. They are denoted as **N** for **Novice** and **E** for **Experienced**.

TEAMS: Level 5 (7-8)Nov, (7-8)Exp, (9+)Nov, (9+)Exp; Level 6 (7-10), (11+)  
Level 7 (9+); Level 8 (11+); Level 9 (13+), Level 10 (15-18)  
Team scores are based on top 3 scores from each event from ALL team members.  
Age Groups – Depending on the entries, some age groups may be combined or split out.
