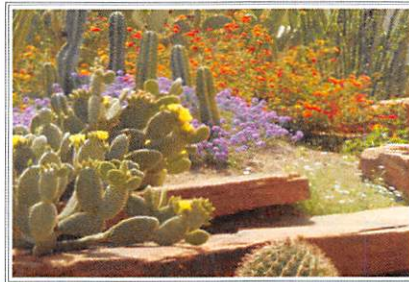
"PLEASE ATTEND A BOARD MEETING AS OFTEN AS YOU CAN"
