Did You Know?

Free Drop Off for Unused Medications

Metropolitan Police Department (Metro) provides an avenue for people who want to safely and anonymously dispose of their unwanted, unused or expired prescription medications.

All medications must be placed in a ziploc baggie, with prescription label blacked out or removed. Place the baggie in the collection box in Metro's Lobby.

Acceptable Items: All expired and unwanted prescriptions and over the counter medications.

Unacceptable Items: Liquids and sharps (syringes and injectable), illegal substances such as marijuana and methamphetamines..

Metro is located in the Regional Government Center, 101 Civic Center Way, Laughlin.
