A message from the UCU Campaign Group at FCH

If management has its way, next semester there will be 30 fewer staff based at FCH. On some courses students will be taught by fewer lecturers or will not have their research supervised by experts, some modules are unlikely to run, and the staff who are left will be **more stress**ed and doing less research. This is on top of the hundred or so staff who left last year, the modules already cut on other campuses, the freeze on book purchases and the tendering of the SU bars. And we anticipate **more cuts to come.** We urge Council and the Executive to stop the destruction of our University in the headlong rush to save cash, reduce the deficit and make loan repayments. We urge that assets be used to maintain staffing levels and expertise in pedagogy, research and the environment during the gradual process of transformation, not just to manage finances. Please, please slow it down, think, plan, truly consult and communicate. Cease compulsory redundancies - or there will not be a University to transform.



What can you do?

It is our belief that the current situation at FCH is not the end of the matter, and that fresh waves of damaging cost cuts and job losses are to spread across other campuses in the coming months under the guise of the Academic Efficiency Review and other operational activities.
