

From the 40 year dessert occupation till the fall of Jerusalem in 70 A.D, the **Sabbath** was observed by a **Lunar Hebraic calendar**.

Note: The word **Saturday** is named after a <u>Roman god of agriculture</u>. It has been called **dies saturni** (**Saturn's day**) The original latin name entered into old english as **saterdaeg** and gradually evolved in the word Saturday. This Saturday that many keep as 7th day sabbath is no where mentioned in the Holy Scriptures, but only found in Gregorian calendar that was instituted by the Roman empire.
